TERMS & CONDITIONS

This form must reach the mensa india (bangalore) office necessarily before 25-Dec-2005.

1. This request form is to be used by a person who has appeared for the mensa admission test at Bangalore (India), but has lost the original test result sheet or for any other reason requires issue of a duplicate test result.
2. Duplicate result letter issuance is a special service and hence the chapter does the same only in specified time windows. The current window is between 01-Dec-2005 and 25-Dec-2005 i.e., the application has to reach the mensa india (bangalore) office between the above two dates. Any applications sent outside this time window shall be processed only in the next window, whenever that is.
3. The service fee depends on whether the duplicate result should be sent to an address within India or to an address outside India and is as follows:
 - ◆ within India, fee is Rs.300/- (Rupees Three Hundred Only)
 - ◆ outside India, fee is Rs.500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only)
4. The form must be complete in all respects and all required documents/fees must be enclosed. Incomplete or illegible forms will be summarily rejected without notice.
5. Once the application has been received, changes to any of the information mentioned in the application are not possible.
6. If the applicant desires to change any information presented in an application (e.g. percentile score), s/he will have to file a completely fresh application along with service fees.
7. mensa india (bangalore) shall begin the investigation into the claim only after the fees have been paid and duly credited.
8. The investigation shall be completed by 30-Jan-2006 and results of the same shall be mailed by 10-Feb-2006.
9. In the event that the details/results are present in our records, mensa india (bangalore) shall issue a duplicate test result sheet.
10. In the event that the details/results are not present in our records, it shall be deemed that the person had never appeared for the mensa admission test under the auspices of mensa india (bangalore) and no duplicate test result shall be issued.
11. In any event, appropriate communication shall be sent to the applicant via e-mail and/or regular mail to the current communication address as specified in the form.
12. The duplicate test result shall be sent through postal service to the address mentioned in this form.
13. The service fee paid is non-refundable and is only towards the investigation and issue of duplicate test result, subject to 7, 9 and 10 above. The service fee cannot be setoff against past/future membership fees or any other dues.
14. Even if the applicant's details are found in our records, the person will not be considered a member of mensa, unless s/he acquires membership by completing all required formalities separately.
